

BELONGING

EYLF: Children's sense of belonging is strengthened when their language, interaction styles and ways of communicating are valued. (EYLF,2022 p.57)

Our Voice: When children are acknowledged and valued for their unique identities—including their non-verbal communication and language skills—they build trust, develop a stronger sense of agency, and become more open to new learning experiences.

RELATIONSHIPS

EYLF: Through a widening network of secure relationships, children develop confidence and feel safe, respected, and valued. (EYLF,2022 p14)

Our Voice: Building happy, joyful relationships with children fosters a strong sense of community, encouraging families to develop confidence and trust in the kindergarten experience.



IDENTITY

EYLF: It is about children knowing themselves; building and maintaining relationships with others, engaging with life's joys and complexities, and meeting challenges in everyday life. (EYLF,2022 p.6)

Our Voice: Building a positive sense of self and understanding their and others culture.

PLAY-BASED & INTENTIONALITY

EYLF: Play-based learning with intentionality can expand children's thinking and enhance their desire to know and to learn, promoting positive dispositions towards learning. (EYLF,2022 p.21)

WELLBEING

EYLF: A strong sense of wellbeing strengthens a sense of belonging and encourages children to trust others and feel confident in Being. (EYLF,2022 p.44)

Our Voice: When children are happy, confident and safe, that will engage positively with others and with the environment.
